

## Foreman

**A Pike Foreman is in charge of crews, primarily in our Distribution and Transmission regions ([see map](#)) although storm restoration also may require work in additional East and Midwest regions. Work is physically demanding, outdoors, in all types of weather – and there's typically quite a bit of travel. You may be required to work at heights or in confined spaces.**

**A Foreman has responsibility for people, safety, and procedures, throughout every aspect of the job site. Typically, there will be several crews for every foreman. When dealing with storm restoration, crew responsibility can be significantly higher.**

**A foreman needs to have industry experience and meet ongoing training requirements, as well as the following minimum requirements:**

- 18 years of age
- Understand all responsibilities and be willing to share knowledge and experience with crews
- Desire to lead
- Self-motivated
- Willing to perform rigorous physical labor
- Able to obtain a Commercial Driver's License
- U. S. Citizen or possess the legal right to work in the U. S.
